Employment terms

Position will be filled through fixed-term employment contracts and can be renewed depending on performance and projects' needs. The monthly time commitment of hired applicant is up to 140 hours, depending on the full or part time status of the relevant project/contract. Insurance is provided through the national health system. A 13th month salary is not provided.

The gross monthly salary for the Senior Research Scientist position will be between €4.000 – 5.300 for full time employment (pro rata for part-time employment), including employer contributions, and will depend on the hired applicant's qualifications and past experience.

The Senior Researcher will work with the CTRL team to enhance existing research tools and platforms, develop and implement new platforms in various environments, automate processes, write technical documentation, contribute to, and manage research projects.
