The Cybersecurity and Telecommunications Research Lab (CTRL) is interested in hiring 2 (two) scientists with computer science or a relevant engineering background to join our team. Please click <u>here</u> to learn about us.

Employment terms

Position(s) will be filled through fixed-term employment contracts and can be renewed depending on performance and projects' needs. The monthly time commitment of hired applicant is up to 140 hours, depending on the full or part time status of the relevant project/contract. Insurance is provided through the national health system. A 13th month's salary is not provided.

The gross monthly salary for advertised positions will be between $\leq 1.000 - \leq 3.500$, including employer contributions, and will depend on the hired applicant's qualifications and experience and its type of employment (full time or part-time employment). Applicants are requested to clearly identify if they are interested in full or part-time employment. Priority will be given to full-time employment applicants.

Role

The scientists will work with the CTRL team to carry out Research & Development activities, setup existing tools and platforms, develop and implement solutions in various ICT environments, automate processes, troubleshoot, and debug software and/or ICT hardware. Furthermore, the scientists are expected to write technical documentation.

Requirements and qualifications

- Preference for a BSc, MSc, or PhD degree in Computer Science or a related engineering field
- Understanding of networking principles
- Experience / Understanding of at least one programming language
- Solid knowledge and understanding of SDLC and object oriented software development concepts and principles
- Experience working with version control systems, such as GIT

- Write clean, scalable code, providing quality work on all projects
- Understanding of Linux and bash scripting.
