Job description

The Cybersecurity and Telecommunications Research Lab (CTRL) is interested in hiring 2 (two) scientists/engineers with computer science or a relevant engineering background to join our team.

Employment terms

Position(s) will be filled through fixed-term employment contracts and can be renewed depending on performance and projects' needs. The monthly time commitment of hired applicant is up to 140 hours, depending on the full or part time status of the relevant project/contract. Insurance is provided through the national health system. A 13th month's salary is not provided.

The gross monthly salary including employer contributions for advertised positions will be between €2000 - €4500 and will depend on the hired applicant's qualifications and experience and its type of employment (full time or part-time employment). These are not remote distance / teleworking positions. Hired applicants are expected to be physically present.

Role

Hired applicants will work with the CTRL team to carry out Research & Development activities, setup existing tools and platforms, develop and implement solutions in various ICT environments, automate processes, troubleshoot, and debug software and/or ICT hardware. Furthermore are expected to write technical documentation.

Requirements and qualifications

- Preference for a BSc, MSc, or PhD degree in Computer Science or a related engineering field
- Understanding of networking or ML principles
- Understanding of Linux and bash scripting.
- Experience / Understanding of programming will be considered an advantage
- Written and oral communication skills in English language
