#### Programme of Study Description

The new undergraduate program (BSc) in Business Economics is designed to provide solid understanding of the central theories and analytical tools of the field of economics and apply these to businesses and the business environment.

The program introduces students to macro- and microeconomic theory and business management, teaches them to think and write clearly about economic problems and policy issues and enables them to develop an in-depth understanding of the economic factors that influence business success and decision-making.

First three years' modules/courses provide a solid background in economics and management, while the final year is more flexible, allowing students to tailor their degree according to their interests.

#### Admission requirements

- Upper Secondary School Leaving Certificate (Apolyterion or equivalent)
- All candidates need to demonstrate that they meet the University's English language requirements by submitting the relevant certificates along with their application (minimum grade IELTS 5.5 or any other equivalent). Details of the specific English language requirements can be found [here](#).
